Paul Ferman: Permanent Past

April 11th - May 6th 2023







Permanent Past looks at Rome through the prism of block universe theory. This suggests that the past, present and future exist at the same time. This possibility was suggested by Einstein and current scientific thinking seems to think it probable.

Permanent Past examines the accretions of 28 centuries of Roman habitation. A layering of history that is compressed in our 'present'. It speaks of a city – on a town – on a settlement – on vacant land. Permanent Past sifts through the sediment of Rome to reveal her spectacular periods of great knowledge and successes and of her science and superstition.

"As an artist who works primarily in photo-based media. I have been exploring how the layering of knowledge and information can be integrated into the conceptual and physical framework of the images I create," says Ferman. "My investigations are about multiple readings, physical impressions and the unreliability of memory. This is in turn reflected in the processes I use for image-making. I have created works that splice images of contemporary Rome with those of historical significance. There are layers of revealing and concealing elements drawn from cinema, architectural forms, etchings and sites of pilgrimage."


